- 1. Go to Porkbun's website.
- 2. Use username <u>ubcrccmarketing@gmail.com</u> and password <u>ubcrccWebs1te</u>\$ to sign in.
- 3. You will likely be asked for a verification code, sent to the Red Cross email. Use username <u>ubcrccmarketing@gmail.com</u> and password <u>UBCRCC202425!</u> to sign in to the email.


Sometimes this sign in can fail, I've found I run into fewer problems using Chrome over Safari.

Updating Payment

Auto renewal is on for this domain, so you shouldn't have to explicitely pay. However, it's currently linked to my (Duncan's) credit card. To change the billing information, follow these steps:

- 1. In the top right, go to Account -> Settings/Billing.
- 2. Update or replace the card using the options on the left.




Removing the Website

- 2. Submit a request to delete the domain.



Google Search Console

To sign in, simply sign in to the marketing google account with username <u>ubcrccmarketing@gmail.com</u> and password <u>UBCRCC202425!</u> and go to <u>Google Search Console</u>.
